



Financial Assistance Eligibility Policy Summary

Beaver Dam Community Hospitals, Inc (BDCH) is committed to provide, without discrimination, care for medically necessary conditions to individuals regardless of their ability to pay. BDCH offers financial assistance under its Community Care Policy.

A person who qualifies for financial assistance will not be charged more than the amount generally billed to individuals who have insurance covering such care.

Who can apply?

All people are able to apply for financial help. This policy provides free emergency care or medically needed care for those who have:

- Ruled out all other payment options.
- Income at or below 150% of the current year's Federal Poverty Guidelines (see chart).
- Submit an application and requested paperwork showing financial need.

A Financial Advocate will work with people who do not have insurance. They will help file paperwork for Medicaid. They can also help people sign up for coverage through the Health Insurance Exchange (HIE).
